characteristics

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- Small plots of land are used
- Family labour for clearing and planting
- Only food crops are grown
- A number of crops are grown
- Production for home consumption

advantages

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- Limits risks of pests and diseases
- Bush burning adds potash to the soil
- Land is allowed to regain fertility
- bush burning also kills seeds of weeds

disadvantages

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- Destruction of natural vegetation
- Does not encourage growth of commercial crops
- Its tiresome due since there is use of rudimentary tools
- Not possible in densely populated areas
